Bk. 6, page 152-153, 20 Jul 1759, Andrew Preslar, Sr. of Anson, blacksmith, to Andrew Preslar, Jr. for $\frac{1}{10}$ land s. side Rocky River, 100 acres granted to Preslar in 1751. Andrew Preslar (seal)
Wit: Thomas Berry, John Culpepper, L. Culcaster.

Bk. 5, page 260, 25 Apr 1759, Peter Preslar of Anson, planter, to Zachary Phillips, planter, for $\frac{1}{5}$ land on S. side Pee Dee join Wm. Smith, 25 acres the mouth of Brown Creek. confirmed to Preslar by deed 6 Dec 1755.
Wit: Morgan Brown, Aaron Smith. Peter Preslar (P)

Vol. I, page 164-165, 21 Dec 1761, John McDaniel of Anson to Peter Preslar for $\frac{1}{20}$ land granted to Thomas Helms 7 Apr 1749 adjoin John Francis corner conveyed to Thomas Coleman 26 Dec 1749, after his death to his son John Coleman, 100 acres. Wit: Samuel Pagett, Wm. Pagett.

Bk. 5, page 67-68, 22 Jan 1763, Peter Preslar of Anson to John Ussery of same for $\frac{1}{30}$ land on N. side Pee Dee granted to Thomas Helms 7 Apr 1749 join John Francis, conveyed to Thomas Coleman by deed 26 Dec 1749 & property ascended to his son John Coleman who conveyed 100 acres to John Meadors.
Wit: J. Denson, James Sheppard. Peter Preslar (P)

Bk. 3, page 159-160, 3 Oct 1764, Peter Preslar of Anson to Owen Slaughter of same for $\frac{1}{5}$, 61 acres on both sides Mountain Creek including the mill, granted to Preslar 2 Dec 1761. Peter Preslar (X)
Wit: Wm. Blewett, Andrew Preslar.

Bk. 5, page 337, 24 Jul 1759, Peter Preslar of Anson to John Henry of same for $\frac{1}{2}$ land on south side of N. fork of Little Pee Dee, 100 acres granted to 7 & sold to Thomas Underwood 24 Sept 1754, then to Peter Preslar 18 Dec 1755. Wit: Wm. Blewett, Morgan Brown. Peter Preslar (P)

Bk. 5, page 189-190, 4 Jun 1771, Wm. McCorkle & wife Ester of Meck. Co. to Thomas Presley of same for $\frac{1}{20}$, 200 acres on north fork of Waxhaw Creek including Humphrey Yarbroughs improvements, join land of John Davis.
Wit: John Davis, Henry Yarbrough, John Crockett.

JOHN PRESSLY #507, 11 Apr 1749, north of Rocky River. (west of Pee Dee)

ANDREW PRESSLEY #898, 25 Feb 1754, south of Pee Dee. (west)

PETER PRESSLAR #1192, 2 Dec 1761, Mountain Creek (east of Pee Dee)

JOHN PRESSBEY #0188, 20 Oct 1767, join James Hutchins.

JOHN PRESSLAR #3336, 4 Mar 1775, Lanes Creek, (west of Pee Dee)

LEVI PRESSLAR #1122, 3 Sept 1779, Lanes Creek (west of Pee Dee)

NOTE: George & Tilmans sons married 4 daus of Thomas Presley. — It is known (Preslar) -- Peter Presley is a descendant of Wm. Presley of Northumberland Co. Va. who acquired 1150 acres in 1649 neighbor to Richard Nelmes (Helmes ?) in 1662 — (Cavaliers & Pioneers, by Neil Marion Nugent) (they intermarried.
